


A VIBRANT COMMUNITY

- Simply sit under a tree with a cold drink and a good book














FACILITIES

THE GROUNDS

- Two ornamental lakes with water features to cool and compliment the tranquil North Queensland style gardens
- Mature trees for shade, and native plants to attract birds and wildlife
- A quiet bushland retreat to give you a place to get away from it all
- Automatic entrance gates with security cameras and an intercom, so you decide who comes in
- Dedicated off-leash dog exercise area
- Storage for your caravan, boat or trailer in dedicated trailer parking with washdown facilities
- Two lakeside pavilions with barbecues for entertaining, or just as a shady escape on a sunny day
- Over 1km of Riverside Walk
- The Zigzag a natural meeting place for neighbours setting out on a Riverside Walk
- The Rotunda another quiet retreat overlooking the Zigzag to the river
- Communal barbecue areas for neighbourhood get-togethers, or for entertaining your family and friends
- Coloured roadways with narrow sections to keep traffic at walking pace, and curves so that you see trees, not garage doors
- Smooth, level paths and walkways wherever possible, to make moving around as safe as possible
- Artworks and sculptures placed through the grounds and illuminated at night



THE SPORT & RECREATION CENTRE

Suncare Lakes includes a complex of sporting, recreation and community facilities mid-way along Birchall Drive. It includes:

Hall

- Meeting Hall with raised stage, lights, sound system and side doors to a paved courtyard
- Kitchen with a servery opening into the hall
- Men's and women's showers and changing rooms to service the pool and golf practice area

Gymnasium

- A gymnasium to work off those extra pounds
- Access to the changing rooms and showers

Consulting Rooms

- Doctor's consulting room
- Beautician's room with separate entrance

Pool

- Quarter Olympic length lap lane
- Large square shallow area for group activities like pool-volleyball and aqua-aerobics
- An access ramp to help people with reduced mobility, or in wheelchairs, into the water
- Access to the changing rooms and showers


Golf Practice Area

Hobby Rooms


- Workshop with a sturdy concrete floor, workbenches, power points, a sink and a large fridge for cold essentials
- Craft room with carpeted floors, work tables, fridge, tea-making facilities and a quiet reading area
















CONVENIENCE & SECURITY

- Suncare Lakes is a 300m level walk along
 Workshops Road from Brassall Shopping Centre,
 2.5km from Thomas Street railway station and
 3.5km from Ipswich station
- The entire complex is fenced, with security cameras watching over the electric driveway gates and pedestrian gates
- You can see your visitors and talk to them on the intercom before you buzz them in
- You automatically qualify for an account to use neighbouring Patterson Lodge's meal, cleaning and linen services
- Twenty four hour, seven day contact with the Patterson Lodge site manager, just in case you lock yourself out, or need assistance

BUYING YOUR VILLA AT SUNCARE LAKES

Buying a villa in Suncare Lakes is easy.

1. Select your villa and location

All the villas at Suncare Lakes feature two bedrooms, spacious and comfortable kitchen and living areas opening to a patio, and reverse cycle air-conditioning that is switchable between bedrooms and living areas at the flick of a switch.

- The "Brassall" offers you two bedrooms and a carport with lockup storage
- The "Yamanto" offers you two bedrooms and a garage with room for a workbench
- The "Bremer" offers you two bedrooms, study and a carport with lockup storage
- The "Eastern Heights" offers you two bedrooms, study and a garage with room for a workbench, in a garden setting
- The "Riverview" looks through the treetops to the Bremer River and offers you two bedrooms, study and a garage with room for a workbench

Once you have selected the style of villa you like, ask the sales-staff to show you which sites are available.

2. Select your interior design scheme

Buying your villa off the plan gives you the opportunity to customise the interior to suit your own personal style by selecting one of three tasteful interior designs:


- The warm earthy tones of the "Nullarbor"

- The urban sophistication of "Fraser"


